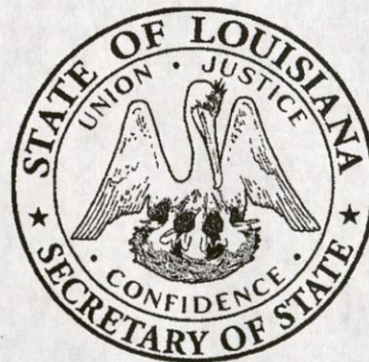

Articles of Incorporation
Student Bar Association
of the Paul M. Hebert Law Center at
Louisiana State University

I. NAME

The official name of the non-profit corporation shall be the Student Bar Association of the Paul M. Hebert Law Center at Louisiana State University (hereinafter "Student Bar Association," "SBA," or "the Association.").

II. PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized and shall be operated as a Louisiana nonprofit corporation to exclusively further charitable purposes. No part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual, nor shall any substantial part of its activities consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate of any political office.

In the event of dissolution, the assets of the corporation shall become the property of an organization, foundation, or fund, organized and operated for charitable purposes designated by the Board of Directors and qualified as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

The Object of the Association shall be to:

- A. Serve as the definitive student governing organization at the Law Center;
- B. Perform the executive, legislative, and judicial functions of the student body;
- C. Represent the issues and interests of the student body to the Law Center administration and faculty and to the community at large;
- D. Foster and encourage the professional competence and the academic achievement of its members;
- E. Implement and promote innovative programming and community service projects through the Law Center;



F. Facilitate and coordinate a number of charitable events to better the surrounding community; and

G. Provide for the general welfare of its Members.

III. DURATION

The duration of this nonprofit corporation shall be perpetual.

IV. TYPE OF CORPORATION

The Student Bar Association shall be a nonprofit corporation.

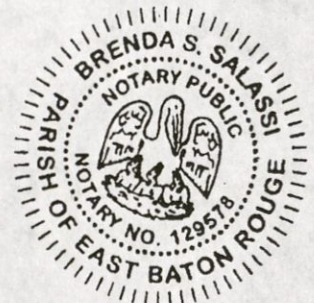
